

## ***Sailing Adventure Packing List (ideally packed into soft-sided luggage for easy stowage aboard)***

### ***Don't Leave Home Without It***

PASSPORT (if checking into foreign ports)  
Cell Phone  
Cameras / Go Pros  
Charging Cables for ALL electronics (esp. cameras)  
Any batteries needed (but spare lithium batteries do not fly)  
Glasses/Contacts/Contacts Case/Saline  
Sunglasses (and a spare pair)

### ***Clothes and Shoes***

Flip Flops/Water Shoes (Texas or dive booties are great when terrain is challenging as it can be at The Baths)  
On board Shoes - We go barefoot aboard. If you'd like to wear shoes aboard, please bring a pair of non-marking boat shoes to be worn only on the yacht – please wear other footwear ashore.  
Hat (ideally wide brimmed w/chin strap or baseball cap)  
Bathing suits and cover ups  
Tank Tops / T-shirts  
Long-sleeved shirts for sun protection  
Shorts  
Sundress if dining ashore and you feel like dressing “up”

### ***Toiletries***

Toothbrush/Paste/Floss  
Reef Safe Sunscreen  
Lotion  
Shaving Kit / Makeup Kit (optional)  
Important Meds

### ***Consider bringing...***

Light Windbreaker  
Computer (back up first) and charger

### ***Please avoid...***

Spray Sunscreen (it stains the decks and cushions)  
Sunscreen containing self tanner or bronzer  
Spray-on Tans  
Oil based products (the decks become slippery)

### ***We Provide***

Shower gel, shampoo, conditioner  
Bath and Beach Towels  
Linens  
Hair dryers and Flat Irons (the boat is 220v)  
A small library of books  
WiFi – please note this is “island wifi” meaning that it can be slow and sometimes it's reluctant to work. It's not the high speed wifi you're used to at home. If you need reliable connectivity, please sign up for an International Data Plan with your cellular carrier. They are about \$10/day and worth it if you crave connectivity!
